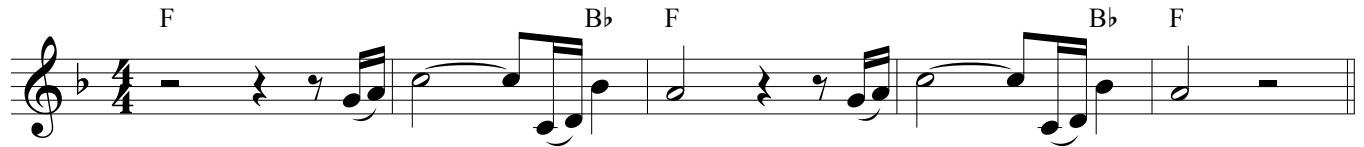


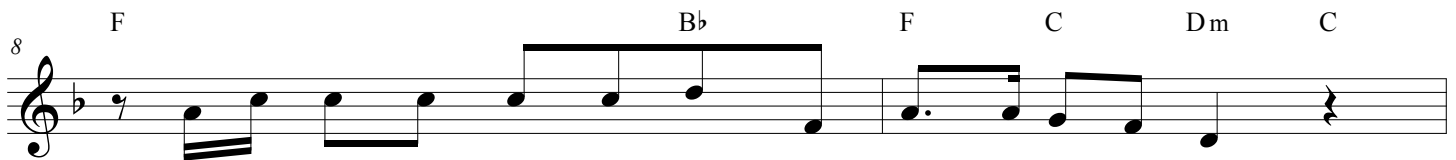

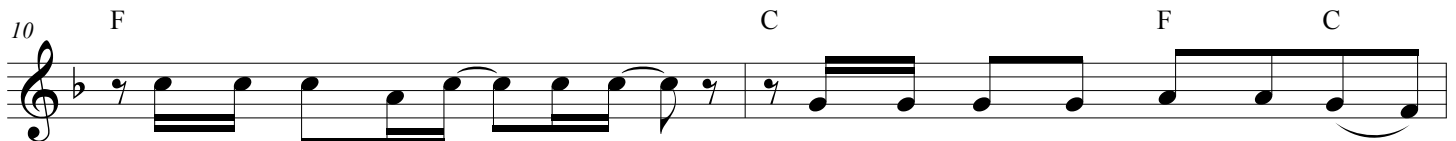

 You can take an out - bound train, Try to make a get - a - way;

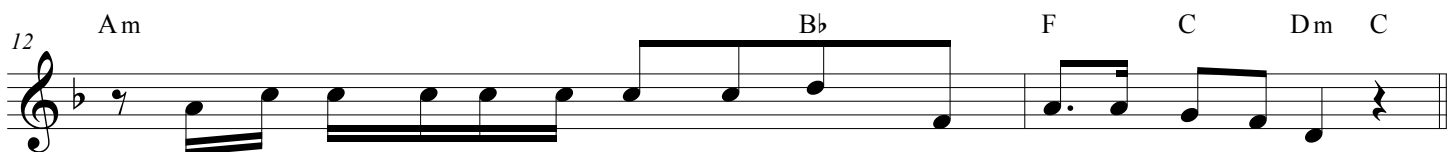


You can build a tall ram - part, Guard it with a gun.
